Exhibition Details

Selected pieces will be displayed as part of the Harvest Christian Art Exhibition in August, alongside visual artworks from local artists. Rather than being sold, these pieces will form part of the exhibition experience, inviting attendees to pause, reflect, and engage with the written word.

Poets whose work is selected will be credited alongside their pieces and included as contributing artists within the exhibition.

Submission Guidelines

- All work must be original and unpublished.
- Submissions should align with the theme of **Community** and reflect a Christian worldview.
- Submit your work as a PDF or Word document.
- Include a short biography (50–100 words).
- Submission automatically grants permission to Harvest Christian Church to display your work as part of the exhibition and related promotional material.
